Please can parents/carers assist school in respecting the school grounds and ensure that you provide close supervision of your child(ren).

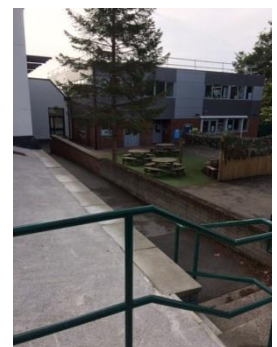
Before and after school, children should **NOT** go on:

- The grassed areas
- Trim Trails
- Wooded area
- Beyond the orange tape and onto the seeded
- Up the KS2 steps
- MUGA (Multi-Use Games Area)



They should also not:

- Play with any school equipment that has been left out on playgrounds
- Swing or climb through handrails and fences around school.
- Stand or swing on the KS1 outdoor reading area (including swinging on the camouflage rope)



During the heavy rain and the onset of Autumn this week and when it is busy on all playgrounds, please be aware that the playground can get slippy. Please keep a close eye on your child.

Thank you for your co-operation in this matter to ensure that we keep the children safe and look after our fabulous grounds.
